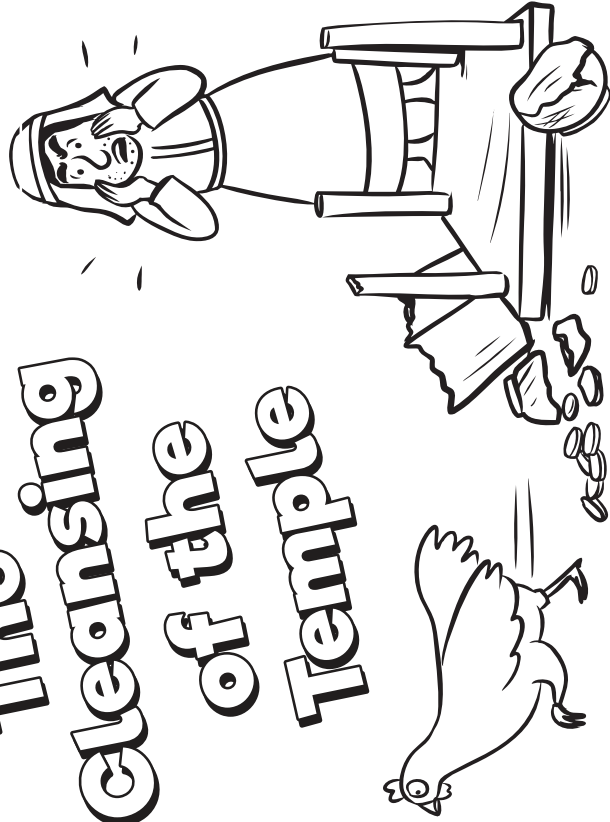


10 MINUTES OF QUALITY TIME

In the temple, Jesus made sick people better and the children in the temple thanked God for sending him!

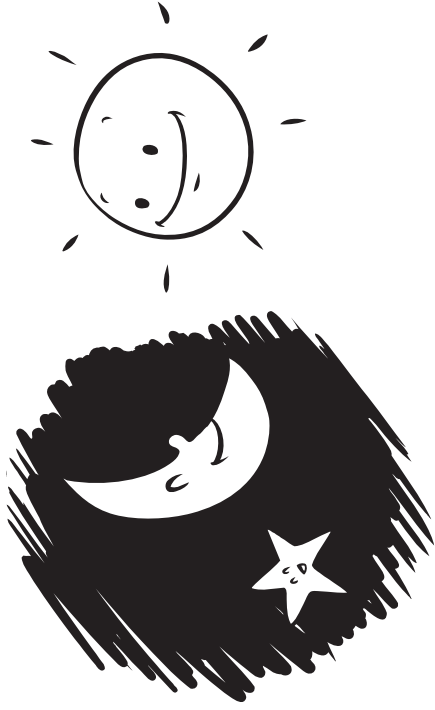


The Creation Story

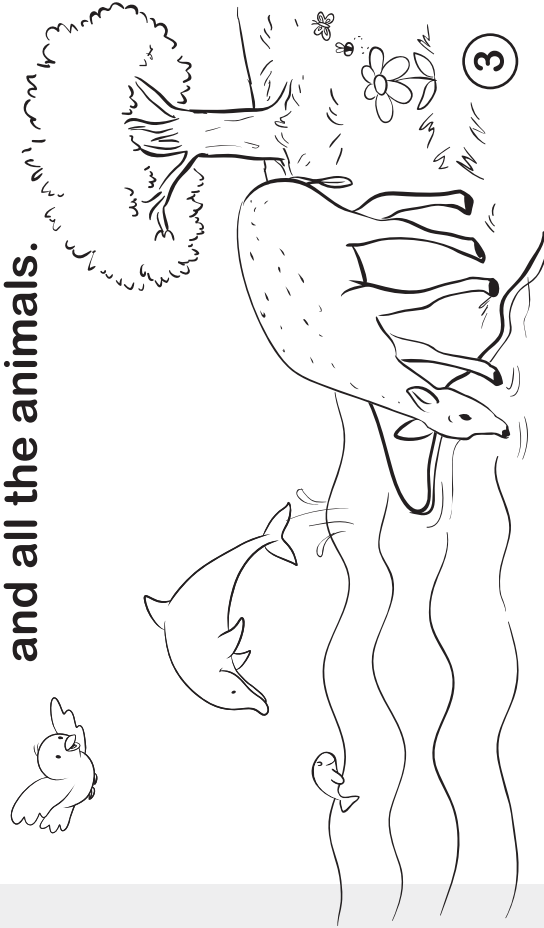


God made everything. He made the light, the dark, the sky, the sun, the moon and the stars.

The Farmer and the Seeds



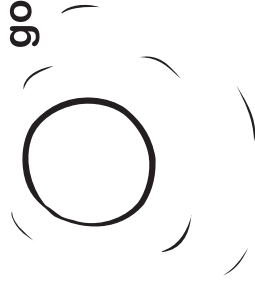

Others fell on good soil and grew more, just like people who hear the truth, believe in God and tell others!

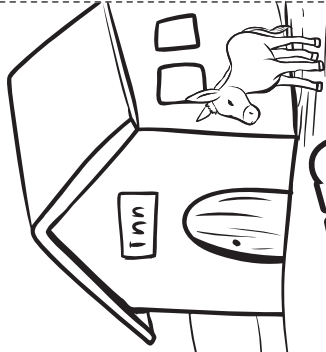

A Samaritan man stopped and helped the man. He cleaned him up, put him on his donkey and took him to an inn where he could be looked after and get better.

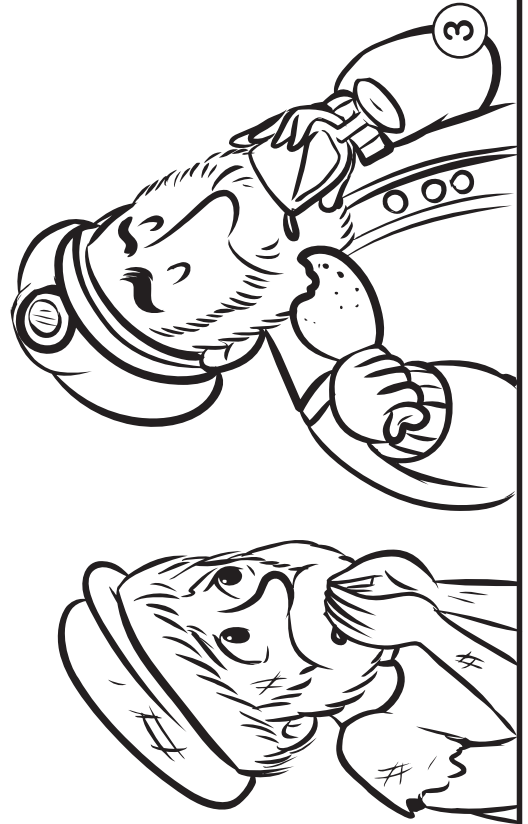




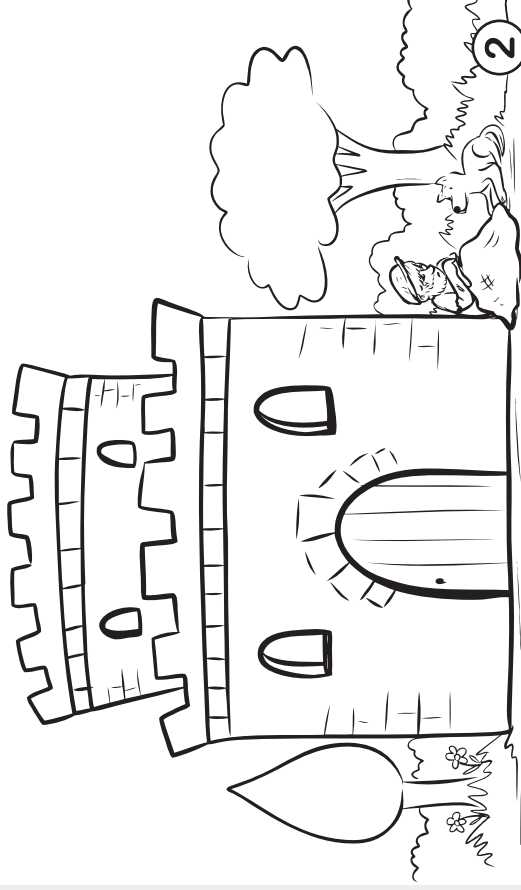
The Parable of the Rich Man and Lazarus

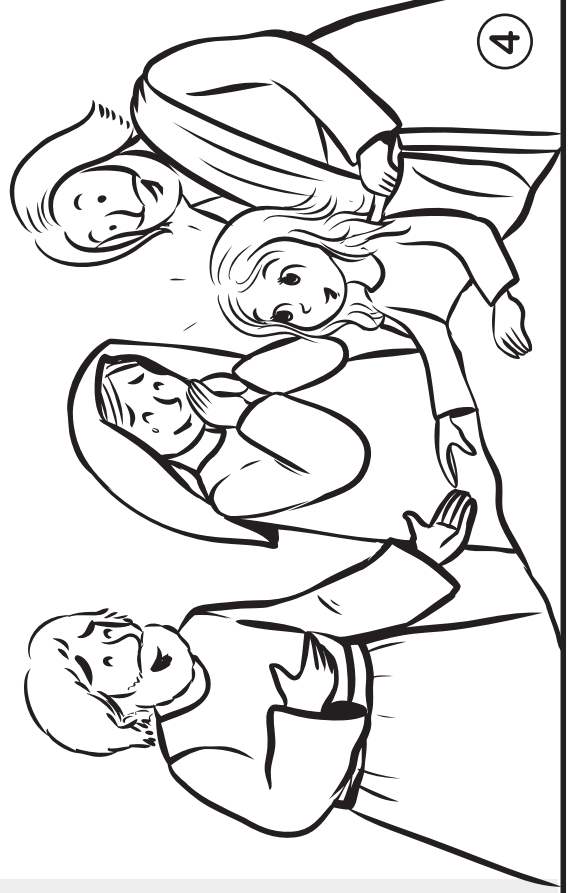
A man called Jairus had a little girl who was very sick. Jairus came to ask Jesus for help.



While Jesus was on his way, messengers came to say the girl had died.

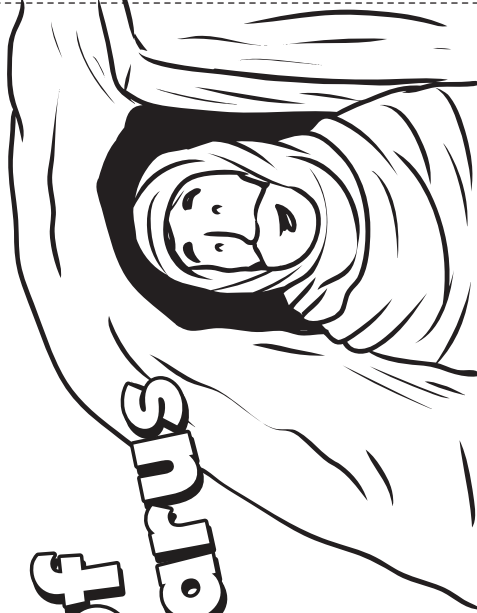


Jesus said to the girl "Get up" and she did! She was alive, and everyone was amazed.

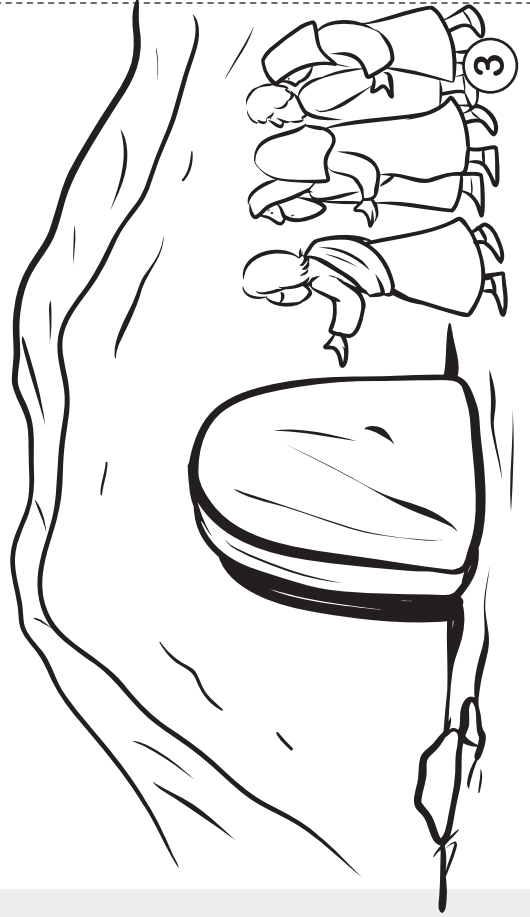


The Resurrection of Lazarus

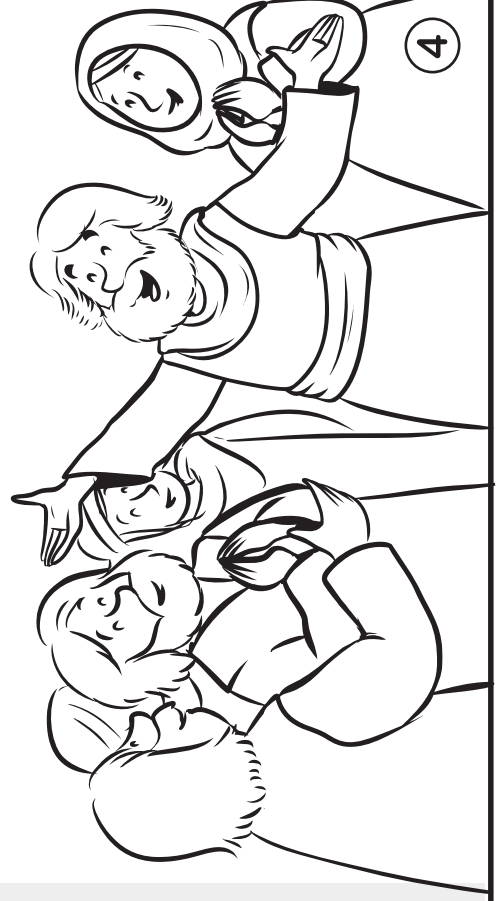
Jesus told his friends that the Holy spirit would come.

Peter told the crowds that this was a sign from God, which brought many new people to believe in Jesus.





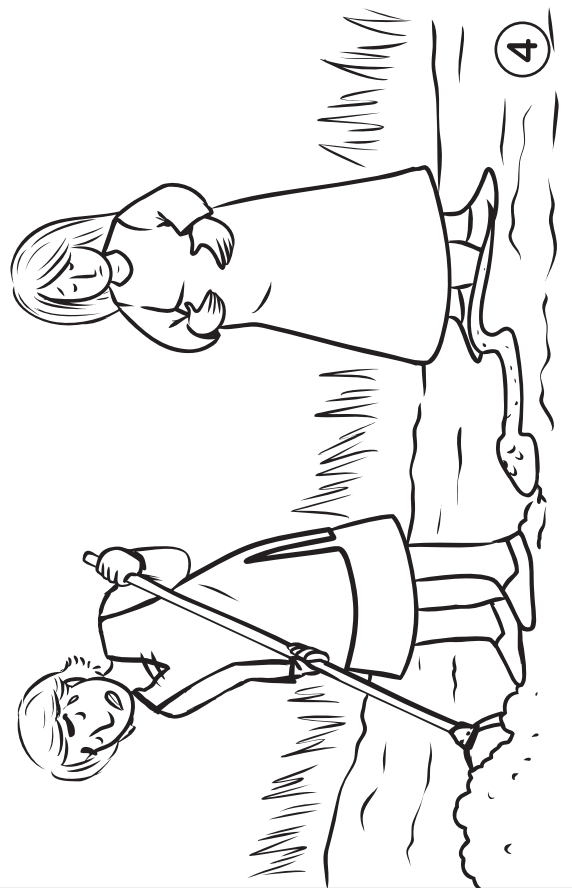
God made a man from the dust of the earth. He made a helper just right for him; a woman.

Jesus chose 12 special friends, called 'apostles'. The apostles traveled with Jesus and learned from Him, and spread his teachings throughout the world.



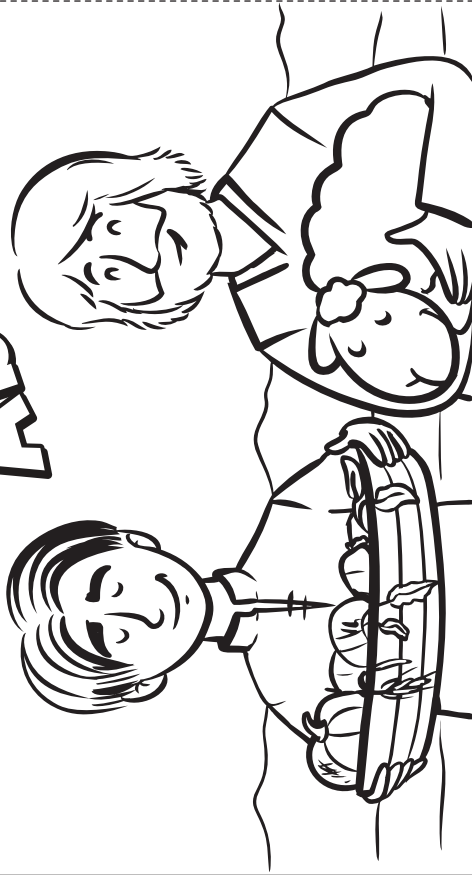
The apostles were called:

Thaddeus Judas ③

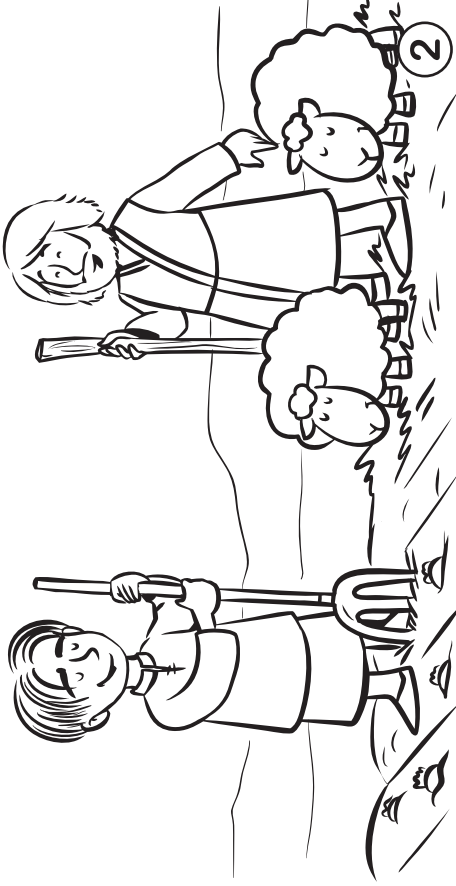
Jesus' 12 apostles were not perfect, but Jesus still chose them, because Jesus saw people, not as they were, but as what they might become.

Healing the Paralytic at Bethesda



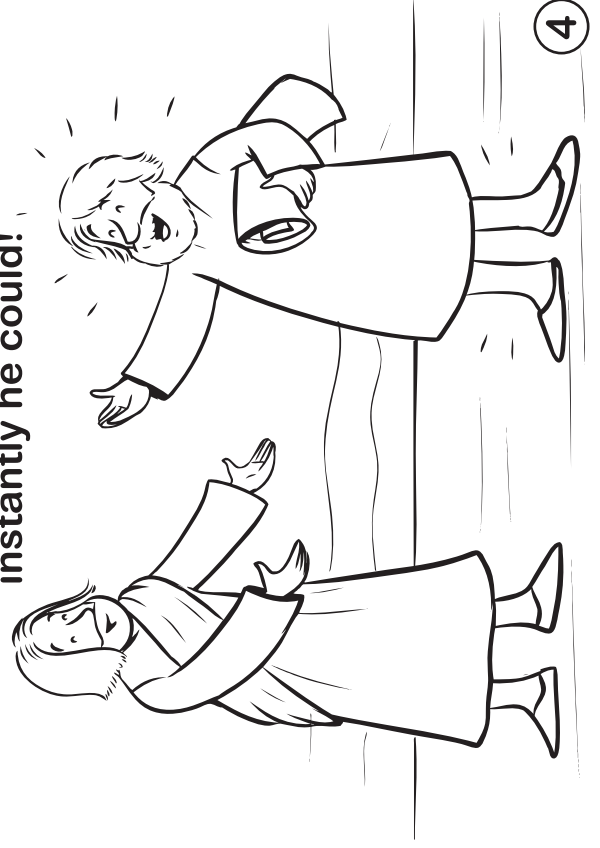
Jesus visited a pool that people believed had special powers to heal the sick. Lots of sick people were waiting.



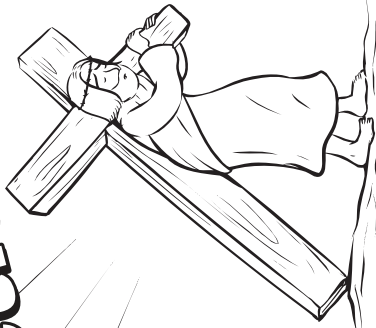
Jesus spoke to a man who couldn't walk and wanted healing.

Jesus' Death and Resurrection

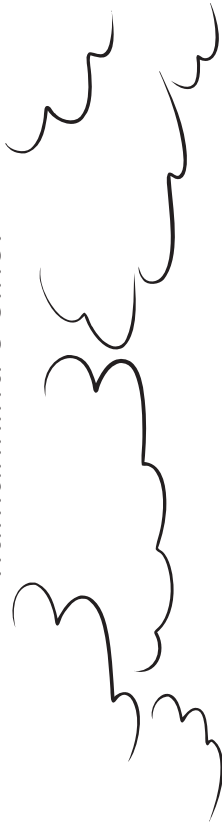

Jesus was arrested and given to the Romans.

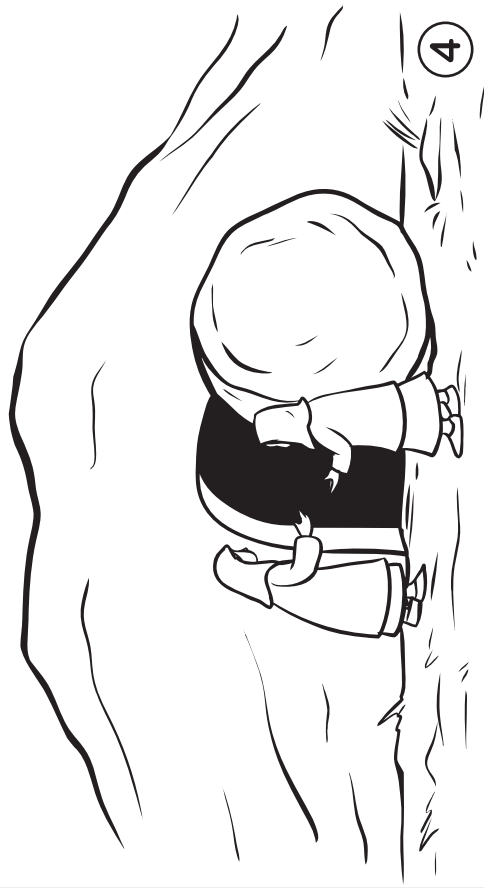


Jesus died on a cross to atone for humankind's sins.

When the women went to visit Jesus' grave, his body was gone and an angel told them Jesus was alive.

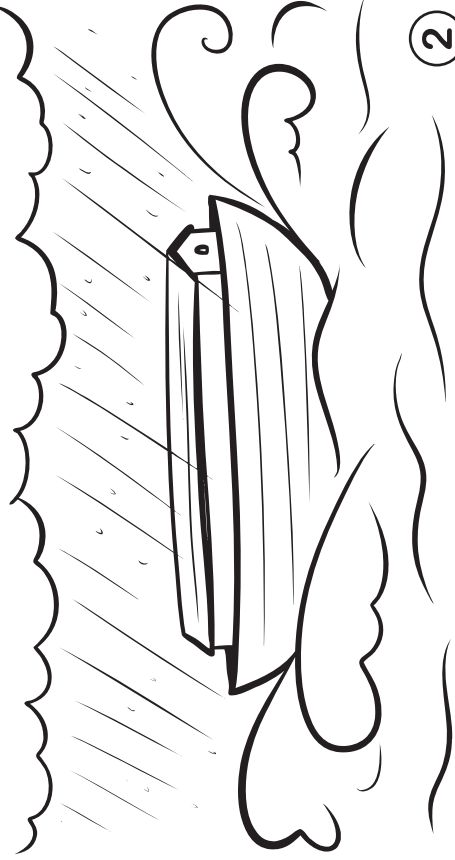

Noah's Ark



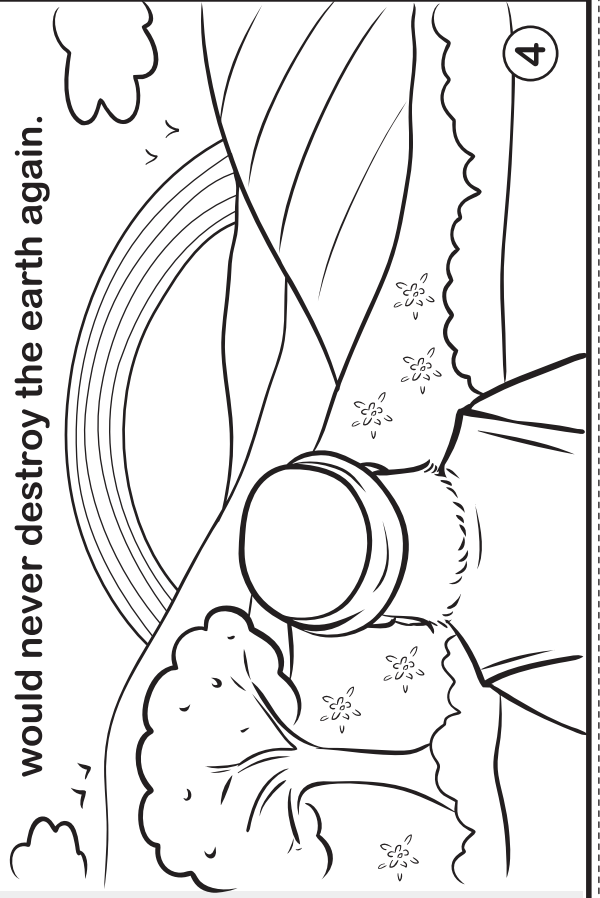
Noah was a good man, but he was the only one who was listening to God, so God decided to flood the earth and rebuild it.

The Birth of Jesus



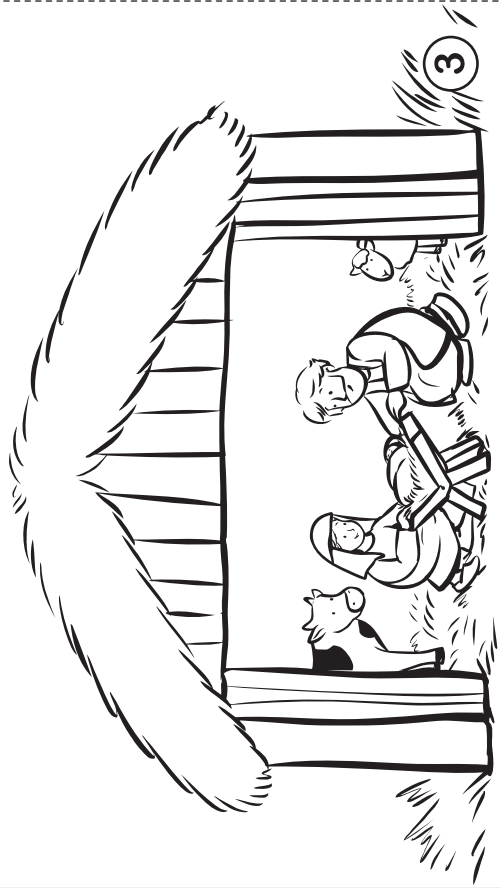
10 MINUTES OF QUALITY TIME
